Whereas Flon Flon Public Library may elect to receive a grant from the Province of Manitoba under Section 2 of the Regulation Under the Public Libraries Act Resepecting Allocation of Grants or, in the alternative, a grant under Section 3 of the same regulations; now therefore be it

Resolved that Flin Flon Public Library elects to request a grant for the year 1976 under Section 3 of the Regulations and that the application be signed by the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, and Librarian, or any two of them.

Motion: Uhrich - Duncan WHEREAS Flin Flon Public Library is financed principally by grants from the City of Flin Flon, the Town of Creighton, and the Province of Manitoba; and

Whereas the grant from the Town of Creighton invariably is paid just before the end of the year; and

WHEREAS the grant from the Province of Manitoba is not payable until later in the year, possibly after July 1st; and

THEREAS funds are required to meet all segpenditures during the first half of the year; now therefore be it

RESOLVED that the Executive of Flin Flon Public Library borrow from the Special Reserve Account such funds as it deems necessary to meet all expenditures, such funds to be repaid to the Special Reserve when and as revenue permits.
